Our PRISMA newsletters are also available as printed materials that can be requested for use in clinics and community settings.

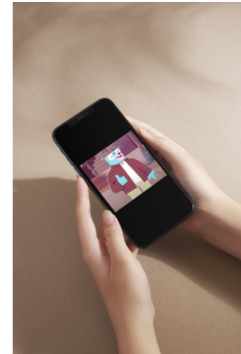
These newsletters provide accessible information about genetics and autism, and can support conversations with patients and families.
